



IN CASE OF FIRE

You witness the start of a fire:

- Stay calm
- Activate the nearest alarm (red block at the entrances of the premises)
- If you see the possibility, try to extinguish the fire without endangering yourself
- If the fire is not controllable, evacuate calmly by referring to the evacuation instructions.

On hearing the alarm signal:

- Stop your activity immediately
- Stay calm
- Close windows, ventilation dampers if applicable, and doors before leaving the room
- Do not use the elevators
- Go to the nearest emergency exit: refer to the evacuation plan of the room concerned and follow the route marked by the green emergency lights (at the top of the corridors)
- Make sure that your partner designated at the beginning of the year evacuates together
- Help people with reduced mobility to evacuate. If it is impossible to evacuate, help to reach a waiting area (not smoked)
- Do not go back

IN CASE OF ILLNESS, ALLERGY, INJURY OR POISONING

- Call 15 (SAMU) or 18 (fire department)
- Ask if anyone in the audience has been trained in first aid



COVID SANITARY PROTOCOL

- Classes will be held in accordance with government health regulations
- **MASK WEARING** : no longer mandatory since March 14, but strongly recommended
- **THE EUROPEAN SANITARY OR VACCINATION PASS** will be requested according to the governmental instructions in force
- When using common equipment (overhead projectors, markers, etc.) and after leaving a seat, wipe with a disinfectant
- Air the premises regularly (5 to 10 minutes per hour depending on the size of the room)

You are « cas contact »

- The current government protocol will be applied (precautions and frequency of testing)

You have tested positive for SARS-Cov2

- Current government protocol will be followed (duration of isolation and frequency of testing)
- Notify your teacher of your absence

IN CASE OF CONFLICT, BRAWL,

- Call 17 (gendarmerie)

Once the people are protected and these calls have been made, inform Science Accueil:
